## Ask Questions. Express Concerns.

Michigan is currently planning for the integration of Medicare and Medicaid funding for people who are eligible for both programs ("dual eligibles").

As a group, these individuals have the most complex needs of all the people served by our health system. They tend to be the low-income elderly and disabled people living in our communities – medically frail, with multiple conditions, living in a skilled nursing facility or specialized residential home.

The state is making changes to help improve care and simplify the rules and regulations for both Medicare and Medicaid. However, with any such major change there are also many questions.

Representatives from MDCH will be on hand to present the key points of the proposed plan and answer questions. Come hear about the plan that the state will submit to the federal government in April.
