



Need Caregiver Support?

In-home Respite

If you are a caregiver providing daily living supports, such as cooking, cleaning, etc., for someone living with a chronic health condition, disability or dementia, and you need help, you may be eligible to receive In-home Respite Support services.

Northern Health Care Management is a recipient of a Merit Award Trust Fund (MATF) Caregiver Support Program grant. These funds are used to provide in-home direct care worker assistance for informal caregivers (friends, family members, and/or others) who deliver ongoing daily care for an individual. This service is intended to provide relief from the demand of caregiving.

To find out if you qualify, call Northern Health Care Management and an Intake and Referral Specialist will help guide you.

If you need help providing long-term care, please call us and we will help you determine if respite care may be beneficial for you.

What we provide

In-home caregiver support for those who provide continuous care.

Who is eligible

If you are providing daily care for someone and you need help, you may be eligible.
