The MI Choice Waiver program provides a wide range of home- and community-based services coordinated by a Supports Coordinator to ensure participants are able to remain as independent, healthy, and safe as possible within their own community. It is a less costly and preferred alternative to nursing facility care that allows people to get the support they need in their own homes.

Our staff have deep experience with complex situations and truly care about finding the best solutions for participants.

This program may provide some of the following services:

- Adult day health (adult day care)
- Chore services
- Community health worker
- Community living supports
- Community transportation
- Counseling
- Environmental accessibility adaptations
- Fiscal intermediary

- Nursing services
- Personal emergency response systems (PERS)
- Private duty nursing/respiratory care
- Specialized medical equipment and supplies
- Training in a variety of independent living skills

There are income, asset and level of care requirements for this program. We have also developed a private pay option for those who do not meet criteria.
