Lower premiums and deductibles

■ **MMAP: Medicare / Medicaid Assistance Program**

Northern Health Care Management staff are specialists who are knowledgeable about Medicare law and regulations. They can help you navigate Medicare's health benefit plans, including Medicare Part D drug plans, to help you make the best choices for your situation.

■ **MIPPA: Medicare Improvements for Patients and Providers**

MIPPA is designed to help low-income Medicare beneficiaries to access programs that make their health care and prescriptions costs more affordable. Eligible Medicare beneficiaries may apply for benefit programs that help to lower the costs of their Medicare premiums and deductibles, including a Low-Income Subsidy (LIS) program for Medicare Part D, Medicare Savings Programs (MSPs), and Medicare Preventive Services. Northern Health Care Management staff can help you determine your eligibility and apply for these programs.
