Applicability

Policy applies to all Managed Health Division employees, Northern Lakes CMHA employees, and contract and network providers.

Policy

The Managed Health Division shall establish standards and procedures for procurement of services that meet the requirements of the Northern Lakes CMHA contract or any other appropriate entity when the need arises for the purchase of services of a substantial nature or which are not available within the existing network. A goal of this process is to keep the procurement process open to any community provider who meets enrollment requirements and the standards of care appropriate to the desired services.

The Managed Health Division may, based upon the needs of the consumer and the market for such services, establish, maintain and utilize a competitive bid process. All purchase of contract services processes are to be conducted in accordance with the guidelines established in the Medicaid Managed Specialty Supports and Services Agreement and any other contract with the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services and any other industry or governmental requirements relevant to the services required. Any changes in sub-contracted providers shall be reported to the NMRE/PIHP within three business days.
