Quick Response Team (QRT)

- The QRT group are a group of community Members that are broken down into Secondary Partners and Primary partners
 - Secondary Partners do not have access to full PHI and/or documents
 - Primary Partners have full ability to talk about PHI, and presenting problems.
- Qualifications
 - A consumer must live in the TC City limits.
 - A consumer must have 2 of the three qualifiers. Mental health, Substance abuse, or Homelessness.
- QRT Goals
 - To help track overdoses, Before, during, and after.
 - the QRT will also address (Respond to) the systemic barriers to recovery by examining gaps in local social service provisions and supporting wrap-around services for vulnerable populations in the Traverse City community.
 - To address the link between substance misuse, mental health & homelessness.

Mobile Crisis

- Responds to Crisis Situations in the community.
- Who can call:
 - Emergency Services (Police, Fire, EMS)
 - Individual having the crisis.
 - Property owner (Parent, landlord)
 - Guardian
- The goal of mobile crisis is to divert from the ER, and get the individual connected to services in the community.
 - Substance abuse
 - Housing resources
 - Primary Care Providers
 - Many other community Resources.
